VISIT THE ICE AGE

The first explorers in Indiana Caverns noticed piles of bones and named the largest room, "Big Bone Mountain." A paleontological survey indicated that the bones discovered were those of much earlier cave visitors – Ice Age bison, peccary and bears. A peccary bone has been radio carbon dated at 40,000 years old. This discovery is of extraordinary importance to science and excitement to southern Indiana.

Indiana Caverns, **the nation's newest show cave**, is now open near historic Corydon, Indiana. As part of the Binkley Cave System, it is **Indiana's largest cave system** and the **11th longest in the United States** at 37+ miles.
